

Walk No.1

A CIRCULAR WALK FROM THE BLACK ROBIN INN, KINGSTON (about 5 miles).

Up Covet Lane, and TR up Church lane to Church. Through churchyard and kissing gate and along tarmac path with hedge on R to The Street. TR down The Street to bridleway on L (CB274). Follow straight ahead and cross footbridge over Nailbourne into parkland. (Charlton Park),

With fence on L continue ahead through metal gate onto lane and in to Bishopsbourne, passing the Mermaid pub on L to 3-way junction near Church. Follow road L uphill (signposted Bossingham and Stelling Minnis).

Ignore R hand bend just after crossing bridge and follow track on L (with old railway track on L) for about 250 yards (CB289). TR up tree-enclosed track to open fields. Continue straight ahead across fields and over stile into wood. Go through wood and follow path across field to copse on R and on to pass another copse on L. TL to follow track (CB276) round this copse, keeping copse on L.

Soon after enter woodland down short steep hill then up ahead keeping to main (often muddy) track to lane.* TL, then in about 60 yards (CB276A) through gate up to another gate: then across field (keeping fence on L) to smaller gate at start of tree-enclosed path down to Marley Lane.*

TR along lane then soon L down track (CB276B) to Covet Lane.* TR for a few yards then L through gate and steeply up half R. At brow continue half L to R-angle in fence ahead. Continue climbing with fence on L through gate to another gate into wood. Follow track up through wood and then downhill with hedge on L. At T-junction TL on to wide track passing Heart's Delight Farm and follow onwards (CB 232) for about ¼M first with hedge each side, then descending through woodland to Covet Lane.

TR and follow lane under old railway bridge down to Valley Road and Black Robin Inn on your L.

NOTE: The walk can be shortened by turning left back to Kingston at these points* * *

KEY – TR = Turn Right TL = Turn Left
