

Walk No 3

A CIRCULAR WALK FROM COVET WOOD (about 2½ miles)

The walk starts at Grid Reference 177488 – where Covet Lane enters Covet Wood near gated road. There is adequate space to park a few cars.

Ascend wide bridleway (CB223) climbing steadily through wood with fine views initially on R. Continue up, ignoring L & R turns to arrive at tarmac lane.

TR for about 50 yards and then L into gap in hedge to stile; proceed half R (CB283) across small field for about 60 yards to another stile, over stile and then slightly L taking path to distant trees in hedgeline*.

TL with hedge on R for about 100 yards along field edge to waymarker post. Bear R through mini copse for 15 yards to field edge. TR along side of field (large hedge on L) for about 150 yards. At waymarker post TL (CB281) across field to another waymarker post, (making for L hand electricity pylon beyond 2 buildings).

Continue at side of farmyard with hedge on R to tarmac lane. TR along this lane following R then L**bends. After about 150 yards past Reed's Mill TR at gate (CB280) across 2 fields (via another gate) to edge of wood. Continue about 50 yards with wood on L and soon enter side of wood at waymarker post along descending track. Continue down through wood slightly L and go down to stile just before Marley Lane.

Cross lane and follow bridleway (CB243) in its winding descent through woods to Covet Lane. TR along lane back to start point about ¼ mile ahead, passing Turks Hill and Covet Cottage on R.

* This section does not follow the definitive map but a diversion is being proposed along the route indicated.

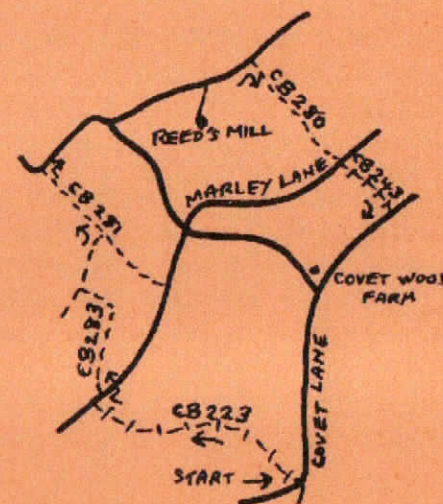
** For shorter walk TR where lane bends L and follow lane straight descending to Covet Lane at Covet Wood Farm. TR and follow lane back to start point.
